Current Digital Wallet Adoption in Southeast Asia

Asia's digital wallet adoption is dominated by China's Tencent and Alibaba.

China's e-wallet success is an example for Southeast Asia players.

The adoption is slow moving in other countries such as Indonesia and even back in Malaysia who see only between 8-10% of their population who have shopped online*.

By 2021, e-wallets payments will account for 16% of total e-commerce transactions in Southeast Asia. An increase from 9%.


